### **GOALS**

No one knows your ministry like you do. If you're like us, you often long for time to pause and think through how things are going and to reflect on how things might move ahead. A Congregational Learning Lab provides you and others from your church the context in which to unlock the energy and creativity that already exists within your congregation.

### **EVENT DETAILS**

## CHOOSING ATTENDEES

The point person for each congregation should review the track details below and hand-pick up to 6 people for each track and ask them to attend. Choose the leaders and decision-makers who can listen to the content, discuss it at their tables, and return to your congregation and leadership with some possible next steps.

### FORMAT/CONTENT

We will offer three different track options that will meet simultaneously. Each track will begin with a presentation by members of MRCC's ministry staff. After a break, each track's participants will return for a facilitated round table exercise with the others from their congregation. This exercise will help them begin to apply the content from the first session to their particular church context.

# Terry Fischer Community Outreach Minister

Terry will present some ideas for "raising the temperature" for evangelism in your congregation and some examples of effective entry points for reaching those with little or no church background. Participants will then evaluate their own congregation's passion and resources for evangelism, identify their own welcome/entry points, and set goals and specific steps for increased effectiveness.



### Josh Kingcade Adult Education Minister

Josh will discuss the role of Bible classes (medium-sized groups), small groups, and how they can complement each other in a congregation's educational and formational goals. Participants will evaluate the health and goals of their own medium and small groups ministries and discuss ways they can work together more effectively.
